Detailed Itinerary:

DAY 01: BANGKOK – ARRIVAL

Arrival at Suvarnabhumi or Donmuang Airport, Bangkok. Meet & Greet at the airport by showing your name on welcome placard and private transfer to the hotel. Check in and free time to rest. **(Standard check in time at 14.00h)**. Overnight in Bangkok .

DAY 02: HALF DAY BANGKOK HIGHLIGHT OF CITY

Breakfast at hotel. 08h00. Departure to visit the highlights of Bangkok city : **Wat Traimit**, the world's largest golden Buddha , **Grand Palace**, includes the visit of Wat Phra Kaew or Temple of the Emerald Buddha, one of the most important Buddha images in Thailand.

NOTE: Grand Palace, you must wear pants long to the ankles, shirt / shirt with long sleeves or up to the elbow.

After visit Wat Pho, is one of Bangkok's oldest and largest temples .Overnight in Bangkok

DAY 03: FULL DAY DAMNOEN SADUAK FLOATING MARKET – MAEKLONG RAILWAY MARKET

Breakfast at hotel. 07h00. You are picked up at the lobby of your hotel in Bangkok city center and then proceed to **Damnoen Saduak Floating Market** in Ratchaburi, is one of the most popular floating markets in Thailand. Every day many Thai and foreign tourists travel here to shop, eat, and absorb the atmosphere of Thailand water markets that have been like this for over 100 years, and it's the straightest and longest canal in Thailand. The canal is 32 kilometers long and has more than 200 branches. Damnoen Saduak Floating Market's popularity grew to new heights in 1971 - 1973 when the river was full of farmers on their boats selling their wares. And that is the way trade is performed in this area until today. Then continue to the **Maeklong Railway Market**, locally called Talad Rom Hoop. It is exciting and fun to watch the merchants and vendors in a rush to fold and remove their goods and umbrellas away from the railway track while the Maekong Train is passing by. Then return to Bangkok and rest on own. Overnight in Bangkok

DAY 04: BANGKOK – CHIANG MAI & HIGHLIGHT CITY TOUR (By flight)

Breakfast at hotel. Pick up at hotel lobby, private transfer to the airport for flight departure to Chiang Mai. Upon arrival Chiang Mai airport, meet & greet with our local guide at the exit door by showing your name on welcome placard, and then welcome you to visit Chiang Mai City tour before check in at hotel. Visit to **Doi Suthep temple**; 3500 feet above sea – level. The main building contains a holy relic of Lord Buddha. Take a walk up to a challenging stair over 300 steps or use the elevator. Enjoy enormous mythological Nagas and a panoramic view of the city can be seen from here. And then continue to visit **Wat Umong or Tunnel temple**; The temple has a unique architecture which has many tunnels. The tunnels were dug to enshrine many Buddhas. This is a center of the meditation which is very peaceful with large shade of the ground. This old temple established in 1296 during the reign of King Mengrai is now widely known as a meditation center devout Buddhists from around the world visit to practice amid its peaceful atmosphere

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and minimalism structures. After that visit to **Wat Prasing**; is one of well-known temple and a must visit during you are in Chiang Mai. The temple houses an important Buddha statue: the Phra Buddha Sihing which gives the temple its name. The origins of this statue are unknown but, according to legend, it was based on the lion of Shakya, a statue since lost which used to be housed in the Mahabodhi Temple of Bodhi Gaya (India). Transfer to hotel for check in and res on own.
Overnight in Chiang Mai

DAY 05: CHIANG MAI – FULL DAY CHIANG RAI GOLDEN TRIANGLE TOUR

Breakfast at hotel. 0700 hrs. Pick you up at hotel lobby, and driving through Northern Thailand's countryside. A short stop at a local Mae Kajan Hot spring and the opportunity to buy coffee and snacks before continuing to visit the one of the most recognizable structures in Thailand, "**White Temple**". This dazzling structure is the ongoing work of a local artist that reflects principles of Buddhism and enlightenment. Continue to the Golden Triangle, a region of Thailand that was once infamously known for its opium trade. It is the spot where the three countries of Thailand, Myanmar, and Laos meet. Take a walk around the viewpoint and explore a small market nearby before resting and having lunch. After that, continue to visit **Mae Sai**, a small trading town on the Thailand-Myanmar border crossing. This is also the most northern city of Thailand. The last stop on the trip is a visit to two incredibly but strikingly different Northern Thai hill tribe villages. **Akha and the Long Neck Karen**. Both tribes wear unique outfits and produce handmade crafts and which visitors can buy as keepsake items. Afterwards, relax on the way back to Chiang Mai.
Overnight in Chiang Mai

DAY 06: CHIANG MAI – BANGKOK – HUA HIN

Breakfast at hotel. Pick up at hotel lobby, private transfer to the airport for flight departure to Bangkok. Upon arrival Bangkok airport, you are met and transferred to Hua Hin (3.30 hrs), check in at hotel and rest on own.
Overnight in Hua Hin

DAY 07: HUA HIN DAY AT LEISURE

Breakfast at hotel and free at leisure own or optional tour with us.
Overnight in Hua Hin

DAY 08: HUA HIN DAY AT LEISURE

Breakfast at hotel and free at leisure own or optional tour with us.
Overnight in Hua Hin

DAY 09: HUA HIN – BANGKOK – DEPARTURE

Breakfast at hotel and free at leisure until private transfer to the airport for your departure flight
