Detailed Itinerary:

DAY 01: BANGKOK – ARRIVAL

Upon arrival at Suvarnabhumi Airport, Bangkok. Meet & Greet with our guide at the airport by showing your name on welcome placard and private transfer to the hotel. Check in and free time to rest. **(Standard check in time at 14.00h).**

Overnight at hotel as per choice

DAY 02: HALF DAY BANGKOK HIGHLIGHT OF CITY

Breakfast at hotel. At 08h00 departure to visit the highlights of Bangkok city :**Wat Traimit**, the world's largest golden Buddha images with a weight of 5.5 tons (5,500 kilograms). This statue was covered with a layer of stucco for almost 200 years until during relocation of the statue in 1955, the plaster was chipped off and the gold revealed as we can see today.

Drive pass through whole Flower market until we reach the historic centre of the city where you will visit **Grand Palace**, a symbol of Bangkok city and former official residence of the King of Thailand between the eighteenth and mid-twentieth centuries and considered one of the most beautiful in the world for its exquisite decoration mixing traditional Thai style with Renaissance influences. During the visit to the Grand Palace includes the visit of Wat Phra Kaew or Temple of the Emerald Buddha, one of the most important Buddha images in Thailand.

NOTE: Grand Palace, you must wear pants long to the ankles, shirt / shirt with long sleeves or up to the elbow.

After that, visit **Wat Pho**, is one of Bangkok's oldest and largest temples, known for housing one of the largest reclining Buddhas in the world. The temple is considered as the first public university and also an original of Thai massage of Thailand. Return to your hotel and take a rest. Overnight at hotel

DAY 03: FULL DAY AYUTTHAYA THE WORLD HERITAGE SITE

Breakfast at hotel. At 08h0 drive to Ayutthaya historical Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Ayutthaya became the second Siamese capital after Sukhothai. There you will be visited **Wat Phu Khao Thong**, is an impressive monument of Ayutthaya. When the Burmese took over Ayutthaya in 1569, the Burmese king built a Mon-style chedi (or pyramid) on top of the former temple to celebrate his victory over Ayutthaya and the Siamese. Visit **Ayutthaya Historical Park** and visit to the ancient palace ground, **Wat Phra Sri Sanphet**, once a royal temple lying beside the Grand Palace, was once the most significant temple during Ayutthaya period. Adjacent to Wat Phra Sri Sanphet is Viharn Phra Mongkolbopit, an impressive building that houses a large seated bronze Buddha image. Lunch at local restaurant. After that you will visit to **Wat Lokaya Sutha** to see the largest reclining Buddha of Ayutthaya with 8 meters high and 42 meters long. Onward to **Wat Mahathat**, a classic temple ruin of Ayutthaya and famous for the picturesque Buddha head engulfed by the Bodhi tree roots. The foundation size and the remaining prangs and towers attest the significance during its time. End of the day drive back to Bangkok for overnight at hotel.

DAY 04: FULL DAY DAMNOEN SADUAK FLOATING MARKET – MAEKLONG RAILWAY MARKET

Breakfast at hotel. At 07h00 pick up at the lobby of your hotel in Bangkok city center and then proceed to **Damnoen Saduak Floating Market** in Ratchaburi, is one of the most popular floating markets in Thailand. Every day many Thai and foreign tourists travel here to shop, eat, and absorb the atmosphere of Thailand water markets that have been like this for over 100 years, and it's the straightest and longest canal in Thailand. The canal is 32 kilometers long and has more than 200 branches. Damnoen Saduak Floating Market's popularity grew to new heights in 1971 - 1973 when the river was full of farmers on their boats selling their wares. And that is the way trade is performed in this area until today's. Then continue to the **Maeklong Railway Market**, locally called Talad Rom Hoop. It is exciting and fun to watch the merchants and vendors in a rush to fold and remove their goods and umbrellas away from the railway track while the Maekong Train is passing by. Then return to Bangkok and rest on own.
