Detailed Itinerary:

DAY 01: BANGKOK ARRIVAL

Upon arrival at Bangkok Suvarnabhumi Airport, our guide will pick you up and transfer you to the hotel in Bangkok for check-in. Overnight in Bangkok

DAY 02: BANGKOK - FULL DAY CITY TOUR

Today meet up at hotel lobby and start our private Bangkok temple tour at the **Grand Palace** and **Temple of the Emerald Buddha (Wat Phra Kaew)**. Explore Thailand's iconic temple and discover the historical significance behind the **Throne Hall, the Emerald Buddha**, and more. Continue visit at **Wat Pho** (Temple of the Reclining Buddha). Pay respect to the golden **Reclining Buddha**, see the colourful gigantic pagodas, and spot the statues showcasing traditional Thai massage techniques. We will cross the **Chao Phraya River by boat** and arrive at **Wat Arun (Temple of Dawn)**. Climb the temple's famous prang (Khmer-style tower) and meet the giants. Back to your hotel . Overnight in Bangkok .

DAY 03: BANGKOK - RAILWAY MARKET - FLOATING MARKET - KANCHANABURI

Breakfast at hotel at 07h00 go directly to **Maeklong Railway Market** so the tourists can see the train crossing the market. Next sightseeing, we go to **Damnoen Saduak Floating Market** only in Thailand you can see the floating Market. An exhilarating narrow long tailed speed boat ride through the small canal pass, Thai Houses and their Vegetable Farm, Flower Farm, Fruit Farm. At Floating Market with the Thai style canoes laden with colorful, succulent fruits, vegetable sweet and meats, gently their way through the canal. Water has always been a major part of Thai Life. Then we go to visit **War Memorial** in Kanchanaburi and its **famous Bridge** over the **River Kwai**. During WW II, Japan constructed the meter-gauge railway line from Ban Pong, Thailand to Thanbyuzayat, Burma. The line passing through the scenic Three Pagodas Pass runs for 250 miles. This is now known as the Death Railway. Overnight in Kanchanaburi

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DAY 04: KANCHANABURI TOUR

Breakfast departure to visit the nearest **Lawa cave** and then **Hellfire pass**, where we walk for about 90 minutes. After walking we are going to visit **Sai Yok Noi waterfalls** close to the road. In the early afternoon we go back to our hotel for overnight. Overnight in Kanchanaburi

DAY 05: KANCHANABURI - AYUTTHAYA

Breakfast at hotel. Check out and Drive to **Erawan National Park** its waterfall (time for swimming here). Then we transfer to **Ayutthaya**. Visit **Ayutthaya Historical Park** and visit to the ancient palace ground, **Wat Phra Sri Sanphet**, once a royal temple lying beside the Grand Palace, was once the most significant temple during Ayutthaya period. Adjacent to Wat Phra Sri Sanphet is Viharn Phra Mongkolbopit, an impressive building that houses a large seated bronze Buddha image. After that you will visit to **Wat Lokaya Sutha** to see the largest reclining Buddha of Ayutthaya with 8 meters high and 42 meters long. Onward to **Wat Mahathat**, a classic temple ruin of Ayutthaya and famous for the picturesque Buddha head engulfed by the Bodhi tree roots. The foundation size and the remaining prangs and towers attest the significance during its time. Continue to hotel for check-in and rest . Overnight in Ayutthaya

DAY 06: AYUTTHAYA - SUKHOTHAI

Breakfast at hotel. Check out and driver to Sukhothai province. On the way stop by Uthai Thani Province then visit **Hup Pa Tard**, the unseen cave which you would feel like you walking back in the time of the dinosaur period. Inside the cave still many rare plants and beautiful site for you to see in the wonderful nature environment. After that continue the road to **Phisanuloke** for you to visit the most beautiful Buddha image in Thailand, **Phra Buddha Chinnaraj the Golden Sitting Buddha Image** as the famous and highly respect for all the Thai people with the graceful and beautiful decoration in the temple main hall. See the local atmosphere of the temple praying. After that heading to Sukhothai for you to check in the hotel Free time. Overnight in Sukhothai

DAY 07: SUKHOTHAI

Breakfast at hotel. This morning explores **Sukhothai Historical Park**, one of the World heritages by UNESCO. The **Dawn of Happiness** where once was the capital in 13th and 14th century Start from the visit to **King Ramkamheang Museum** for you to get some information of Historical Park before taking a pleasant bike ride in the historical park area for you to stop by with the beautiful buildings in old Thai architect and many chedis which spread out in the historical park to remind us how beautiful city in the old days. See **Wat Pramahathat** as the biggest temple in the historical park area, **Wat Pra Pai Luang** was the ritual center of Sukhothai at the that time, **Wat Chang lo** rm with 32 elephant statues surrounded as the pagoda supporters as well as **Wat Sri Chum** with the talking Buddha as the highlight which challenge you if you could get him all in the picture. Overnight in Sukhothai

DAY 08: SUKHOTHAI – CHIANG MAI

Breakfast at hotel. continue to **Sri Satchanalai**, the former sister town of Sukhothai. You will visit the famous temples in Lampang, **Wat Phra Dhat Lampang Luang** and **Wat Phra Keo Don Tao** before proceeding to Lamphun. Visit **Wat Haripoonchai**, a Burmese-style temple. Finally, arrive at Chiang Mai and stop for lunch. Drive to the holy mountain temple **Wat Phra Dhat Doi Suthep** the most sacred temple containing a holy relic of the Lord Buddha. The temple compound offers an exhilarating view of Chiang Mai city and surrounding countryside. Continue to hotel for check-in. Overnight in Chiang Mai

DAY 09: CHIANG MAI – HALF DAY ELEPHANT CAMP – HIGHTLIGH CITY TOUR

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Breakfast at hotel. This morning we will drive approximately 1.5 hours South of Chiang Mai through rolling hills, forest, and local farming areas. Arrival the **elephant camp**, learn about the elephants and change into traditional Karen clothing. Meet the elephants. Feed, interact, and play with the elephants in a natural environment as you learn about their behavior and history. Take photos with the elephants, Mud Spa with the elephants, walk with the elephants to a river and bathe them. Eat a traditional meal and then say goodbye to the elephants. After that exploring Chiang Mai highlight city tour. Visit **Wat Umong or Tunnel temple**; The temple has a unique architecture which has many tunnels. The tunnels were dug to enshrine many Buddhas. This is a center of the meditation which is very peaceful with large shade of the ground. This old temple established in 1296 during the reign of King Mengrai is now widely known as a meditation center devout Buddhists from around the world visit to practice amid its peaceful atmosphere and minimalism structures. After that visit to **Wat Prasing**; is one of well-known temple and a must visit during you are in Chiang Mai. The temple houses an important Buddha statue: the Phra Buddha Sihing which gives the temple its name. Return to hotel and rest . Overnight in Chiang Mai

DAY 10: CHIANG MAI

Lying south of Chiang Mai, the granite mass of **Doi Inthanon**, 8,500 feet above sea level, is the highest summit in the country. Enjoy exploring around Ang-Kha Nature Trail at the highest peak viewing beautiful Fern & Moss. Visit the Twin Pagodas built by the Thai Air force in honor of their Majesties King and Queen for their 60th Birthday Anniversaries. Stop on the way down to shop at Hmong Tribal Market who trades various kinds of vegetation, temperature fruits and flowers from their own farm. Last stop at **Wachiratarn Waterfall**. Relax by fresh and clear fall for freshen up after a long day tour. Overnight in Chiang Mai

DAY 11: CHIANG MAI DEPARTURE - PHUKET

Today you will check out and transfer to the airport to take onwards flight to Phuket. Upon arrival Phuket airport, you are met and transferred to hotel, check in and rest on own. Overnight in Phuket

DAY 12 – 15: PHUKET DAY AT LEISURE

Breakfast at hotel and free at leisure own or optional tour with us. Overnight in Phuket

DAY 16: PHUKET – DEPARTURE

Breakfast at hotel and free at leisure until private transfer to the airport for your departure flight
